Improves the quality of core programs and boosts academic support:

- Revamps the finance system so every school can provide essential services and well-rounded programming.

- Expands access to early education programs and prekindergarten so children enter school ready to learn.

- Expands advanced coursework, electives, clubs, extracurricular activities, and after-school care.
- Provides more career training in relevant, high-demand fields that align with local workforce needs.
